Playground Committee Report:

Elevator repairs were estimated at \$2500, \$1500 donation from Viterra; repairs have recently been requoted, hopefully the new quote will be less than originally quoted.

RVSD requires funds up front before purchase order can be submitted.

Monique Williams motioned up to \$1000 for society to cover the extra expenses; Ethane Jarvis seconded, all in favor, carried.

Colin MacDonald will reconcile the playground expenses and ensure taxes are credited back to the school account. We should know a final amount of the loan soon since the landscaping has now been completed.

There was discussion that perhaps the school loan be increased slightly to bridge the gap between field trip expenses and when casino funds would be deposited into society bank account, (estimated date of deposit April/May 2019). Chael Wyper said Society would be ok to pay field trip fees by end of school year (June 2019).

Waterton Field Trip

Email vote to put a maximum of \$200 towards food expenses for the grade 5 field trip that got canceled after traveling to the Waterton Cabin area. They decided to do a sleepover in the Indus School gym for one night. They requested money for food for the kids. Katherine Winkler motioned (actual cost was \$99.75 for pizza everything else was donated by parents)

We re-motioned for this matter at the council meeting due to Katherine having a child in the grade 5 class that was affected by the cancellation.

Ethane Jarvis motioned to approve, Emily Paxman seconded. Carried.

Fundraising Report:

Dueling Pianos – Andrea Desjardins reported that Michelle Alm will chair the committee. Michelle has chaired the committee previously. \$13,000 was profit in 2016-2017. Need a committee, volunteers, Potential dates April/May - Andrea Desjardins will check hall rental

dates with BVAS. Fee would be discounted if we could do the same weekend as another organization.

Christmas Raffle in December – Char Gosling will coordinate. No budget needed

Bottle Drive Fundraiser at Back to School BBQ September 11, 2018. Easy to do and made \$868.45. Thank you Charlene Gosling for the use of trailer and taking the bottles in. Plan to do another drive week of Oct 15 in conjunction with school events taking place: book fair, student led conference and Evergreen Theatre. We can determine frequency after this next bottle drive. Possibly January for the next drive.

WestJet Raffle. Andrea Desjardins reported that the WestJet Raffle June 2017 sold 1583 tickets at \$7915; expenses were \$236.25 ticket printing, \$200 incentive parties; totalling \$7478.75 profit. It is not a guarantee that we can get the raffle each year. WestJet gift card draw – ISCS would pay for gift cards but it was decided we do not have the funds to put up front at this time.

Other fundraising ideas

Adults/Kids Paint Fundraiser in November; kids paint fundraiser raised \$900 and adults paint fundraiser raised \$1125. Charlene Gosling will contact Firehouse to see if they will partner again.

Casino Chair Report:

Casino slotted for March 8 and 9, 2019 - Need volunteers for 48 shifts, there are 5 key positions which need to be filled. Andrea Desjardins will need to send paperwork into AGLC 60 days prior. Andrea will bring paperwork to next meeting in November.
